All issues below have been addressed and tested in line with Mainpac Pty Ltd's usual development and quality processes.

Financial Assets
The Acquisition Date (some organisations may refer to this as the "install date") is now available as search criteria on the financial asset Component search screen.
The Component tab on the Financial Asset screen now has two extra columns on the Financial Components grid: Original Cost and Acquisition Date.
When performing a depreciation claim run, the Process Assets screen indicates whether this is a projected claim run or an actual claim run.

General
Users who do not have permissions to edit lookup fields (and other Table entries) are still able to use Table values when maintaining records.
Certain fields in the application are intended for specific purposes, e.g. to enable use of PDAs or for interfacing with other systems. These field types are hidden by default but can be made visible via the Screen Manager.

A data dictionary is now available for Mainpac and will be updated on an on-going basis. For further information, contact Mainpac's Client Services.

Labour Resource Management
When a Labour Resource record is deleted, Authorisation records for that Labour Resource are also deleted to ensure that reports and records use current details only.
When using the lightning bolt function to switch between Labour Resource records the photo items update to the newly-selected Labour Resource.
Documents can now be attached to Authorisation records.
Labour Resource records now have a General tab.
Users are able to add Transactions regardless of their permissions to view Resource Type and Labour Resource records.
Authorisation parents and pre-requisites can be of any type (i.e. Work Related or Access), regardless of the type of Authorisation the parent or pre-requisite is being entered against. E.g. a parent/pre-requisite of type "Work Related" can be added to an Authorisation of Type "Access".

Purchasing

Functionality available via Save buttons is dependent upon profile permissions, e.g. if the user has no permission to add a record type the button does not display the option to "Save & Add New".

Reports

The search screens for selecting Report criteria have been enhanced. There are now a greater number of search screens to choose from, available when editing Reports.

KPI weekly and monthly compliance reports now have hyperlinks for accessing the related record within the Mainpac application, for all "list" type reports, i.e. excludes charts and trends. (These KPIs use the data warehouse which is not a standard part of the Mainpac installation. For further information, contact Mainpac Client Services.)

Work Orders

Work Orders for descendant operational views can be created via Work Order Templates stored at a the parent operational view. (Use the Work Order Template's context menu to create the new Work Order.)

When copying a registered Work Order Request (to create a new, unregistered Work Order Request), the application does not carry the Work Order number across from the original request.

The Description field for Work Order steps has been increased from 100 characters long to 4,000 characters long.
